Responsibilities:

- Work with the Facilities Manager to maintain the facilities and camp grounds
- Assist with landscaping, mowing, building repairs, cleaning, and program projects
- Participate in three evening activities per week and provide coverage for counseling staff
- Complete regular trash removal from all public areas of camp
- Assist with luggage and camper transportation during check-in and check-out days
- Assist in the timely cleaning of all public areas of camp – complete janitorial duties
- Maintain hydration stations as dictated by the camp schedule

Qualifications:

- 16 years or older
- Resilient, positive, “can do” attitude and willingness to learn new skills
- Ability to bend, lift, carry, load and unload items up to 50 lbs
- Ability to perform repetitive work throughout shift
- Adhere to program standards as well as risk management policies and procedures
- Serve as a Christian role model to campers and fellow staff
- Build/maintain positive relationships with campers/staff
- Follow all camp policies and procedures
- Ability to pass background check
- Excellent communication, and interpersonal skills essential for community living
- Experience working with kids OR the disabilities community desirable
