



## Camp Nurse (RN)

**Summary:** We're hiring for a variety of RN and LPN positions to complete our health center team for the 2022 summer season. Whilst it is preferable for our staff to reside at camp for the duration of the season, we are willing to work with the right applicant to make the role fit around their schedule.

**Contract Dates:** June 19 to August 12, 2022 - staff orientation occurs the week of June 10-17, 2022.

**Time Off:** Friday PM to Sunday AM (6 weekends) - Flexible working to cover 1-2 weekends required

**Salary:** \$1150-1350 per week (commensurate with experience/credentials)

**Accommodation:** Our nurses and medical assistants work and live in our modern Health Center facility which is air conditioned and conveniently located in the center of camp, and staffed 24 hours a day, with a minimum of two nurses.

**Supervision:** Nurse Manager provides medical supervision

**Benefits:** \$500 completion bonus for residential staff, room and board, laundry facilities, WIFI, MA license reimbursement, use of camp facilities outside of working hours.

### Residential Summer Camp Nurse is responsible for:

- Oversee the administration of medication to campers at designated med-pass times
- Organize camp paperwork and maintaining files/records
- Provide first aid care to campers and staff as needed
- Monitor the health and cleanliness standards of camp, clinic and living areas
- Coordinate visits to physician or hospital as needed
- Order medical supplies and keep the infirmary stocked
- Work closely with Nurse Manager to provide adequate physical health conditions for staff and campers

### Qualifications:

- 21yrs of age with RN License - Must have MA nursing license or obtain one before camp begins
- Valid CPR and First Aid certification and Driver's License
- Ability to pass background check and provide 3 positive references
- Communicate effectively in English (verbally and in writing)
- Flexible approach to working in a fast-paced ever-changing environment
- Desire to work with children and adults with disabilities in a residential camp setting essential

**Physical Nature of the Job:** The ideal candidate(s) must be able to navigate steep hills, uneven terrain and work in hot/humid conditions, lift up to 25lbs and walk for at least 1-2 miles without a break.
