Responsibilities:

- Be actively involved in all aspects of the Day Camp program including adherence to schedule, mealtimes, engagement at activities, administrative duties, cleanliness of space
- Actively participate in setup, pack down, meetings and daily debriefs
- Assist with planning, implementing, and evaluating the weekly theme, program elements
- Participate in two evening camp activities per week
- Serve as a Christian role model Build/maintain positive relationships with campers/staff
- Follow daily schedule and manage transitions to ensure timely arrival/departure of your unit
- Facilitate group activities for your campers during free periods
- Mediate and de-escalate any conflicts that may arise between campers/staff
- Complete daily chores to maintain the cleanliness of your facilities and equipment
- Report any notable concerns or incidents to leadership staff

- 16 years or older with 2 years of applicable experience in childcare, youth ministry, teaching or camp counselor
