- Plan and prepare schedule/activities modifications/continuity in accordance with weather/feedback
- Train, manage and motivate a team of Program Instructors
- Evaluate program quality and success, continuously to meet desired standards
- Ensure local laws and regulations are followed in accordance with Staff Policy Manual
- Assist with de-escalation of conflict situations among campers and staff
- Follow all camp policies and procedures and hold staff accountable to the same
- Work closely with the Camp Director to plan and implement special events such as 4th July and Christmas in July
