Responsibilities:

- Oversee, train, manage, motivate, and mentor Resource staff members on a daily basis
- Oversee and manage the Waterfront Director and ensure local laws and regulations are followed.
- Work closely with the Summer Camp Director and other leadership staff to ensure continuity of program.
- Follow all camp policies and procedures and hold staff accountable to the same.

- Ability to work independently, as well as part of a team
- First Aid/CPR certified
- Teaching certification preferred, but not required
