About Grotonwood Camp & Conference Center:

Grotonwood is located across 275 acres and 1.5 miles of shoreline on Lost Lake in Groton, Massachusetts, and has been running day and overnight Christian summer camps for youth, families, and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities since 1956. Our goal is to introduce people to the love of Jesus, and encourage them to grow in relationship with Him. At the heart of this life changing experience is the staff, committed Christians who want to live out an example of a life changed by grace. In this context, through fun and fellowship, lives are transformed and hearts are renewed.

Responsibilities:

- Oversee the Waterfront in the afternoons; run scheduled activities in the mornings and evenings,
- Supervise daily swim-time for day, youth overnight, and adult campers
- Coordinate lifeguard rotation and break schedule
- Plan, run, and evaluate in-service training sessions with lifeguards weekly
- Manage and maintain the Waterfront and Boating Area according to all local and state regulations

Qualifications:

- 21 years or older
- YMCA or Red Cross Waterfront Safety Instructor (WSI) certification
- Boating experience preferred, but not required
- Leadership experience required
- Ability to engage audience
- Dynamic, over-the-top personality with a “can do” attitude
